



## Pupil Provision Mapping

The pupil premium is additional monies given to schools to support pupils who are considered disadvantaged. The chosen measure for this is the entitlement of Free School Meals within the past 6 years. The current funding is approximately £73,020 in total. Estimated costs have been allocated in the following way.

### Interventions

**Overview:** provision of TA time to deliver intervention programmes to support children (refer to yr group intervention timetable)

**Cost:** TA salary

**Aim/outcomes:** To accelerate rates of progress in all subjects across all year groups

### Year 6 Booster Sessions

**Overview:** Morning sessions run by Year 6 class teachers for maths and reading/SPAG to close the gap.

**Cost:** no cost

**Aim/outcomes:** To accelerate progress in maths and English and support children meeting national expectations in SATs.

### Ipads

**Overview:** 10 Ipads for using with children to support learning

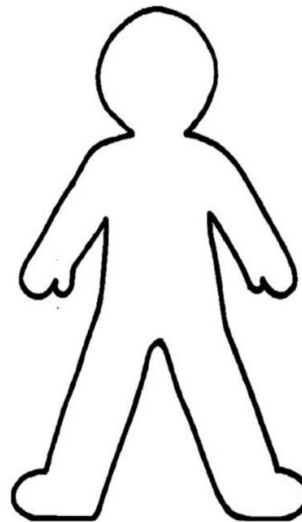
**Cost:** funded by PTA

**Aim/outcomes:** To accelerate progress in all subjects across all year groups

### Intervention Resources

**Overview:** Meemo intervention - works to improve working memory and short term memory. On Track Maths – to target specific objectives to support maths understanding

**Cost:** £350

**Aim/outcomes:** To improve children's working memory to support their learning. To make accelerated progress in maths.

### Homework Club

**Overview:** Key Sage 2 homework club- to support with learning and creating a calm learning space to complete their work.

**Cost:** no cost

**Aim/outcomes:** To accelerate progress and support children meeting learning goals. Ensure homework is completed in a calm environment with adults who are able to support not hinder learning.

### Extra-Curricular Sports Clubs

**Overview:** Monies available to support children in their choice of after school sports clubs.

**Cost:** dependent on number

**Aim/outcomes:** To provide a range of opportunities and equal access for all children and promote healthy active lifestyles.

### Extra-Curricular Clubs

**Overview:** Monies available to support children in their choice of after school clubs.

**Cost:** included in sports club cost

**Aim/outcomes:** To provide a range of opportunities and equal access for all children

### Subsidised Trips

**Overview:** School trips and residential subsidised to ensure access for all pupils

**Cost:** dependent on number

**Aim/outcomes:** Raise aspiration, motivation and engagement. Improve behaviour. Give a purpose

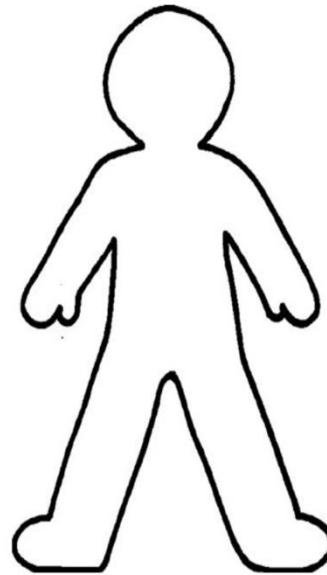
### Music Lessons

To provide a range of opportunities to children who would not otherwise be able to partake in the

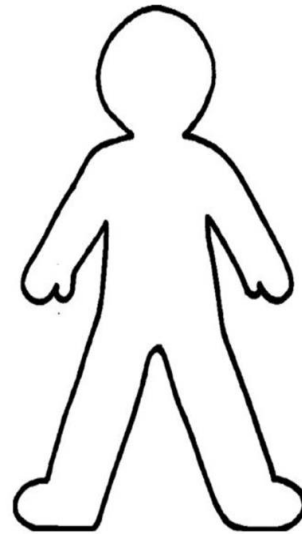

### Breakfast Club

**Overview:** Free places for those in most need to breakfast club

**Cost:** dependent on no of ch

**Aim/outcomes:** Increased attendance, support for working families. Ensuring children have a good breakfast before school.

### Access to Family Support Worker

**Overview:** Children who require nurture support are able to spend time with our family support worker

**Cost:** FSW salary

**Aim/outcomes:** To promote a positive learning culture within school where all children are able and ready to tackle the learning of each and every day and manage social situations with increasing confidence.

### Uniform/Equipment Provision

**Overview:** School Uniform and sporting equipment (swimming costumes etc.) provided for those in most need

**Cost:** dependent on needs of year

**Aim/outcomes:** To promote a sense of well-being and belonging to the school community through quality

### Access to Education Psychologist

**Overview:** School pays for its own ed psych to support children with a range of needs

**Cost:** 11% of Education Psychologist salary

**Aim/outcomes:** Identification of individual needs, leading to clarification of expected outcomes and progress towards these for all

### Play Therapist

**Overview:** A space for children with different needs to be supported and given a safe space to express themselves

**Cost:** £252

**Aim/outcomes:** To promote a positive learning culture within school where all children are able and ready to tackle the learning of each and every day and manage social situations with increasing confidence.

### Nurture Group

**Overview:** The nurture group is a short-term intervention providing a caring, stable and supportive home/school environment for children exhibiting social and emotional difficulties

**Cost:** £19,690

**Aim/outcomes:** The intention is to help the children develop a positive self-image and improve their social skills so that they can learn successfully when they return to their school full-time.
