Free School Meals

More parents are registering for FSM because of the current situation. If you wish to check eligibility please go to our website – Our School – scroll down to School Meals - scroll down to Free School Meals. As soon as you register the school will be informed and can supply the £15 per week per child vouchers. Please be reminded that the Universal Infant Free School Meals offer that is available to all pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 does not mean your child is eligible for FSM. You have to register under the criteria. If you have older children in receipt of FSM and a child in the infants you must register the younger child in order to receive your voucher for the younger child.

Reminders

Due to the changes in government guidelines regarding Coronavirus, we just wanted to remind you of what you should do if someone displays symptoms.

The most important symptoms of coronavirus are recent onset of any of the following:

a new continuous cough

a high temperature (over 37.8 degrees Celsius)

a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia).

If anyone has any of the symptoms above they should self-isolate for at least 7 days. Please inform the school office. Everybody in their household should also self isolate for 14 days from when they first developed symptoms. Anyone who displays symptoms should arrange to have a test. There is a testing station at

As your child moves into year 3 they will no longer be eligible for universal infant free school meals (UIFSM).

School meals should be booked via ParentPay at a cost of £2.40 per meal.

We are an idling free zone. Please switch your engine off.

Keep safe on school grounds by not cycling or scootering on the premises.
