English- Online Learning

Activity 1: go to <https://teachers.thenational.academy/lessons/to-understand-the-features-of-adverts-65k3ed> Watch the video and learn about the features of advertisements. Now design your own advertisement about healthy food.

Activity 2: Go to <https://teachers.thenational.academy/lessons/to-develop-a-rich-understanding-of-words-associated-with-meals-crt64d>. Watch the video and work through any tasks. In your homework book write down all the words that you have learnt and add dictionary definitions to them. You can use an online dictionary to help you or use your own .

Activity 3: Think about an unhealthy meal. Draw a picture and label it. You can colour it in if you like. Now draw a meal with some healthy foods and some unhealthy food. Label it as before. Lastly draw a picture of a meal that is completely healthy. Label and colour in.

Activity 4: Go to <https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/b08mp5wv/cbeebies-presents-goldilocks-and-the-three-bears>. Watch Goldilocks and the three bears. As part of our fairy tale topic you will be re-writing the story of Goldilocks and the three bears but Goldilocks will be trying out three different dinners. Daddy bear will be having the unhealthy meal. Mother bear will be having the part healthy part unhealthy meal and baby bear will be having the healthy meal. Write out a basic plan for your story.

Activity 5: Draft your story and edit. Now write up your fairy tale. Remember in fairy tales it always ends with, 'and they lived happily ever after'.

Reminders: Read every day for at least 20 minutes.

Challenge: Look at other fairy tales and see how you could incorporate healthy food.
