

What if someone tests positive or has symp-As Christmas approaches we are aware many toms? Do they need to isolate? Self-isolate

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or

You should also self-isolate straight away if:

- you've tested positive for COVID-19 either according to a PCR test or a lateral flow device test – this means you have the virus. If you get a positive LFD test you should book a PCR test. A negative PCR test will override a positive LFD test.
- someone you live with has symptoms or tested positive (unless you are not required to self-isolate – see below if this applies to you)

you've been told to self-isolate following contact with someone who tested positive find out what to do if you're told to selfisolate by NHS Test and Trace or the NHS COVID-19 app.

Pupils should only self-isolate if they have symptoms or if they get a positive PCR or Lateral Flow Device (LFD) test.

We will space out chairs, ensure there is ventilation and recommend you complete a lateral flow before attending. However, if COVID numbers rise nearer the time, performances may be cancelled and will be filmed instead.

#### Year 2
