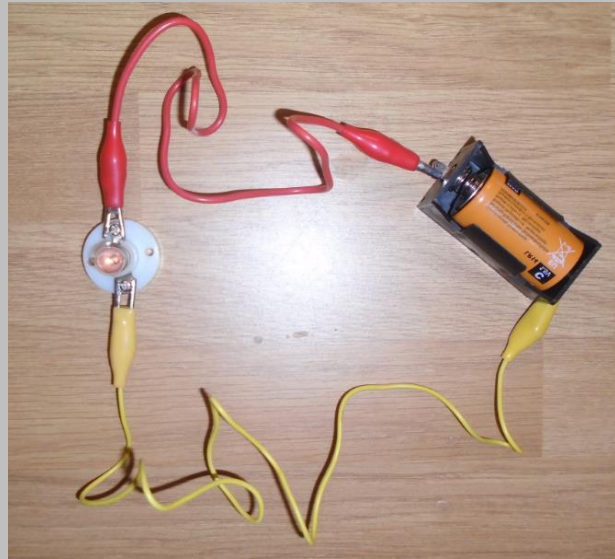


Year 4 Spring Term

Successful Learners

Areas of learning

As historians, we will learn about our history from the fall of the Roman Empire up to the Battle of Hastings in 1066. This will include the Scots and Picts and invasion and settling of the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings.

As scientists, we will learn about the different states of matter and how they change (solids, liquids, gases).

As designers, we will design and create a model torch using circuits and junk modelling.

In English, we will read the Wild Robot and empathise with the main character through diary writing. We will explore Roald Dahl's Charlie and the Chocolate Factory and develop our skills through persuasive writing and a write a newspaper report.
