Clubs –Summer Term – Please apply before Friday 20th April

Welcome to our summer term clubs. We advise you to check the dates carefully as some clubs are not running consecutively.

Our clubs need to have a minimum and maximum number of children to be able to run successfully. If a club is oversubscribed names will be drawn from a hat. You will only be notified if your child does NOT get a place. As part of our risk assessments, we check that club providers have put in place their own protective measures and encourage you to check too.

Rugby Robots, an introduction to coding will start again this term and a Gardening Club will start at lunchtimes but is limited to 10 children only. We offer ukulele and drumming and additional music lessons can be arranged through Richmond Music Trust www.richmondmusictrust.org.uk

Clubs run by Outside Agencies:

All outside agencies have DBS checked staff. As they are external agencies, we would like to draw your attention to the fact that during these classes the teacher from that club is totally responsible for the welfare of your child, including first aid, and has your registration form with your contact details.

How to book a Club

1. Please complete a registration form for all clubs which will be given to the club provider so that they can contact you directly. All your information will be destroyed securely afterwards. You will also have to book directly/enrol to Boundless Dance, Street Dance and Rugby Robots.
2. Please make payments to the individual club providers listed in the information attached.
3. **Place your registration form in the club's box outside the school office. A separate registration form is needed for each club. Please do not put cash in the box.**
4. If you would like any more registration forms, please ask the school office.
5. **You will only be notified if your child does not get a space in your chosen club.**

Enspire Drama

Enspire Drama teaches towards the LAMDA qualifications. The clubs are run by Tim Ryan. If you are unfamiliar with LAMDA, it is basically the same as any musical instrument exams that your children would take. They are nationally recognised qualifications that look excellent on secondary school applications, CVs and at grades 6, 7 & 8 even help your child achieve university entrance through UCAS points.

The lessons are designed to improve a variety of life skills, using drama-based activities.

Drama builds confidence, communication skills, initiative, teamwork, compromise, perseverance and respect – all vital life skills, whatever your chosen path. The best bit is that children often do not realise they are building these skills during each lesson of drama we provide.

Your children will be taken to the club at the end of the day.

No special kit is required and the children do the sessions in bare feet. If your child is wearing a dress/skirt, please provide them with either leggings, shorts or skort for them to put on underneath to avoid them showing their underwear, accidentally.

The Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 club begins at 4:25pm. Your children will be looked after by our staff until their session begins. Alternatively, they could attend a different club before their drama starts. Please provide a snack, reading book or homework as you see fit.
